A Note to All Parents

Dear Parents,

August 29, 2025

Thank you for allowing your child to serve in this year's Children's Christmas Eve Mass. Before you all make the commitment to join, I wanted to make sure you all were aware of a few details:

1. I know that parents know their children's strengths and limitations best. If your child is in the Angel Choir age group but has a long attention span (2 Full Hours including Warm-up, Prelude & Mass), they may rehearse/sing in the Loft Choir.
2. If your child is in the Loft Choir age group, but has a short attention span, they may rehearse/sing with the Angel Choir.
3. Please remember that the Angel Choir will only rehearse/sing the Prelude Section of the Mass. The Loft Choir will rehearse/sing for both the Prelude Section & for All of Mass.
4. When you drop your child off for rehearsal, it is imperative that you stay close by in the event that your child may need you to take them to the restroom or any other incident. Please do not go to Mass or leave the building.
5. If your child has any special or behavioral needs, (ADD, etc.) please stay in the room to help control their behavior. When a child displays that they are not able to attend a 30-45minute rehearsal without disrupting, this tells me that they will not be able to handle the 1-2 hour time commitment for the Christmas Eve Mass. Thus, I reserve the right to ask them not to participate.
6. Please sign your child in upon arrival and please be prompt in picking up your child at their assigned end time. Also, it is important to remember that Virtuus requires that your child is not left unattended with an adult alone. *Thank you for taking the time to read and sign this document. I am looking forward to working with you, your children, & The Holy Spirit to make our 2025 Children's Christmas Eve Mass the most Spirit-filled yet! God bless you all!*
